Destroy this sanctuary, and in three days I will raise it up.

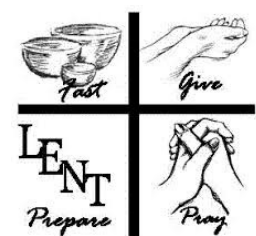

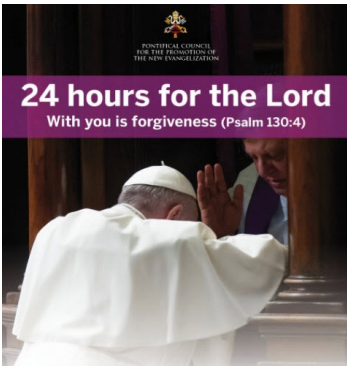
