

◆ ***Palm Sunday Liturgies (8th/9th April) in Mudgee: Please wear red to Palm Sunday Liturgies***

especially to the Ecumenical Blessing of the Palms and Liturgy of the Word at St John's Anglican Church on the Sunday. Please assemble at St John's Anglican Church before 9.00am. As is the custom of previous years we will assemble at St John's 9.00am for the Blessing of the Palms and Liturgy of the Word and process back to St Mary's for the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Children from the parish are invited to participate in the procession with palms and streamers. The donkey will be there.

◆ ***Commissioning of ALL Eucharistic Ministers - Holy Thursday.***
