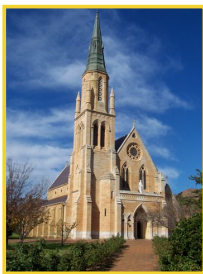

### REFLECTION by Diane Bergant CSA

We have been in the in-between time since the Ascension of the Lord. Today we celebrate the dramatic inbreaking of the time of fulfilment. We celebrate the fullness of the Spirit and the great gathering of nations. The feast also brings the Easter season to its conclusion. Today's readings recapitulate many themes that appeared throughout the Easter season: Christology, Trinitarian theology, reign of God, repentance, salvation, mission, universality. All are brought together as we are brought together into the body of Christ.

The plan of salvation has been brought to its conclusion. Christ is exalted next to God and has sent his Spirit to fill the earth with God's power. The world is charged with divine energy; it needs but a spark to ignite it with life and with excitement. This vitality explodes into the extraordinary: tongues are loosed and speech overflows its linguistic constraints; charismatic gifts flood the valleys of human habitation; barred doors are burst open and frightened hearts are calmed. The Spirit of the Lord fills the whole world.

Strangers assemble to fulfil personal obligations and they experience a phenomenon that bonds them together for life. Individual religious devotion is swept up into communal divine revelation. Through the Spirit of God, we are reconciled to each other and then together we spend ourselves for the common good. The world is renewed; the community is revitalised; we come to know the mysterious yet all pervasive peace of Christ.

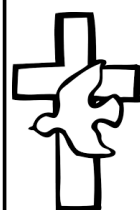

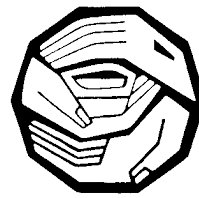

## A message from Bishop McKenna



Dear Friends in Christ,

On 26th June, it will be ten years since I was ordained Bishop of Bathurst. I look back on this time with gratitude to God and to all of you who have walked with me on our common pilgrimage.

I will mark the anniversary this year in Rome, where Pope Francis has called the Australian bishops for our visit "Ad Limina Apostolorum" ("to the threshold of the Apostles"). These gatherings take place usually every five years, though it will now be actually seven since our last one.

The Catholic Church is fully present in each diocese with the essential ingredient of communion with the Bishop of Rome, successor of St Peter. At the heart of each bishop's ministry is the guarantee of that communion between the particular church he pastors and the universal Church. The *ad limina* visit is a tangible expression and practical exercise of that communion.

In addition to meeting with Pope Francis, we also meet with his collaborators in the various departments of the Holy See; and offer the customary Masses at the tombs of the Apostles. We shall make a retreat, too, in preparation for next year's Plenary Council.

On 26th June this year, we are to celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St Paul's Outside the Walls, where the remains of the Apostle Paul await the Resurrection. On that day, I will ask the Lord for the grace of renewal in my ministry; and bring to the altar the prayers of God's People of the Diocese of Bathurst. Please pray for me.
